Information for people with walking difficulties and wheelchair users

All areas relevant for testing meet the quality criteria of the label "Accessibility certified - partially accessible for people with walking disabilities".

Some **information on accessibility** are listed below. In the separate document "Detailed information" detailed descriptions are available.

- There are 2 parking spaces in front of the holiday apartment for people with disabilities (parking space size: 350 cm x 500 cm; distance to the entrance: 8 m).
- The building is steplessly accessible via a ramp. The ramp has a maximum gradient of 5 % and a total length of 3 m.
- All rooms usable by the guest are accessible at ground level.
- The doors are at least 82 cm wide, corridors at least 140 cm and passages 150 cm (exception: side bedroom with 90 cm).
- The manoeuvring spaces in front of essential immobile furnishings are at least 150 cm x 150 cm.
- In the kitchen, the table, sink, stove and worktop are accessible by wheelchair.

Bedrooms (double rooms with connecting door)

- The manoeuvring spaces in the bedroom are variable, as the beds can be moved.
- In bedroom 1 the manoeuvring spaces in front of essential stationary furnishings (e.g. wardrobe) and left and right of the bed are at least 150 cm x 150 cm.
- In bedroom 2 the manoeuvring spaces are: in front of essential stationary furnishings (e.g. wardrobe) 87 cm x 200 cm; left of the bed 200 cm x 180 cm and right of the bed 75 cm x 180 cm.

Sanitary room

- The bathroom door opens and closes automatically after a brief touch (with motor support).
- The manoeuvring spaces are as follows: in front of the washbasin and the toilet 150 cm x 150 cm; right next to the toilet 30 cm x 55 cm, left 60 cm x 55 cm
- There are handles that can be folded up to the left and right of the toilet.
- The shower area at ground level is 135 cm x 150 cm.
- There are horizontal grab handles.
- The washbasin is wheelchair compatible and the mirror can be seen while standing or sitting.
- An alarm trigger is not available.

Information for people with hearing impairments and deaf people

Some **information on accessibility** are listed below. For more descriptions please see "Detailed information".

- There is no visual alarm in the building.
- A television with teletext is present in the living room.
- At least one free electrical outlet is available near the bed.
- Free WiFi access is available.

Information for visually impaired and blind people

Some **information on accessibility** are listed below. In the separate document "Detailed information" detailed descriptions are available.

- · Assistance dogs are allowed.
- The entrance is not visually rich in contrast
- Glass doors are not marked with safety markings.
- There are no carousel or rotary doors.
- · Rooms and corridors are brightly lit.
- There are no obstacles, e.g. objects protruding into the path/room.
- Information is not available in Braille or prismatic writing.

Information for guests with cognitive impairments

Some **information on accessibility** are listed below. For more descriptions please see "Detailed information".

- Business cards/brochures with address and telephone number of the host are visibly displayed in the bedroom.
- The destination of the route is usually within sight.
- There is no colored or pictorial guidance system.

Information on the "Tourism for All" labeling system

All establishments and locations certified with the label "Tourism for All" meet the following quality criteria:

- Data and information on accessibility are collected and checked on site by **external**, **specially trained evaluators**. The method is not based on self-assessments.
- Data on accessibility is available **in detail** and can be viewed by the guests.
- At least one staff member has successfully passed a **training** on "**Accessibility as a comfort and quality feature**".

The labeling - explanation of the logos and pictograms

The label "Information about Accessibility" indicates that detailed and verified information on accessibility is available for all groups of people.

The label "Accessibility certified" is based on "Information about Accessibility". It means that the quality criteria defined for specific groups of people are met partially or completely.



Accessibility certified



The label "Accessibility certified" is available in two requirement levels:

"Accessibility certified: partially accessible".

The quality criteria are partially fulfilled for the pictured group of people, i.e. the establishment/location is partially accessible for wheelchair users. The "i" in the pictogram indicates that it is recommended to read again carefully whether the offer meets all (your oder the guest's) individual requirements.



"Accessibility certified: accessible".

The quality criteria are fulfilled for the pictured group of people, i.e. the establishment/location is accessible for wheelchair users.
